What Are They?

The Sapindus Mukorossi, more commonly known as the “soap nut tree” can be found throughout the foothills of the Himalayas. For centuries, the Sapindus Mukorossi seeds have been harvested for the natural cleaning surfactant, Saponin that is contained within their shells. The

Sapindus Mukorossi tree is heralded as the premier producer of Saponin as its fruit shells contain the highest quality natural soap in the world.

Harvested only when the soapberry fruit falls from the tree, the shells are removed from the seeds and dried naturally in the sun, with no chemical processing. To complete the eco-circle the seeds are used to plant new Sapindus Mukorossi trees. As the trees will yield fruit for up to 90 years, the soap nut is a lasting natural resource.



About the MonkeyNuts Packet

Each packet contains multiple MonkeyNuts soap seeds
Each packet can be used for 4 – 6 loads of laundry (large hot water loads 4 washes, small cold water loads up to 6 washes)

It is safe to use at double strength, 2 packets for extra large or heavily soiled.

How do I use my MonkeyNuts?

Before adding laundry, toss 1 unopened packet of MonkeyNuts into the washer. Use two packets for extra large or heavily soiled loads. Rest assured that your clothes are now being cleaned naturally with Saponin – creating the smallest ecological footprint possible.

After your wash cycle is complete remove the packet and set it aside until your ready to do your next load.

Reuse the packet until the seeds open up, become squishy and begin to lose shape



(good for approximately 4 – 6 loads of laundry).
